Practical elements

Vocational subjects

- Music - 5 hour practical exams
- Sport studies - Demonstrate sport skills and coaching
- Hospitality - 4 hours cooking exam
- Design and Technology- Producing a product

GCSE Subjects

- Art - 10 hour practical exam
- Drama - Performance exam
- Spanish - speaking exam

July 2026	Option subject allocation confirmed
