## Re: Year 12 Visit to University of Warwick Open Day - Thursday 4th July 2024

We are delighted to invite all our Year 12 students to this very important event. The University of Warwick <a href="https://warwick.ac.uk/study/undergraduate/">https://warwick.ac.uk/study/undergraduate/</a> is a Russell Group University. It is one of the UK's leading universities for excellence in research, teaching and innovation and the university boasts excellent graduate employability records. The agenda for the day will include:

- Academic and Student Life Talks
- Information about Student Support Teams (Pastoral and Academic Support)
- Student Finance and Independent Living/Budgeting
- Accommodation

Students will also have the opportunity to talk to current undergraduates and ambassadors in a variety of disciplines. At Warwick prospective undergraduates will have the flexibility to study modules outside of their main degree subject, and to study a foreign language.

## **Travel arrangements**

All transport and insurance costs will be paid for by The Thomas Alleyne Academy. Students must arrive at **8.00 am** and go straight to the sixth form centre for registration. We will leave Thomas Alleyne at **08.15 am** to travel by coach to the University of Warwick. We will return to Stevenage by approximately 3.30 pm, depending on traffic. When we are nearer Stevenage, we will ask students to text parents/carers if they need a lift home.

## **Dress code and refreshments**

On this occasion students may wear casual (but appropriate) clothing and comfortable shoes as the campus is large. Students need to bring their own packed lunch and refreshments/water.
